KWPN Honors Gudrun, Dam of Ulysses M2S

Morningside Stud's bloodlines are well-represented in the 2007 Preferent and Prestatie Mare list recently published by the KWPN.

Gudrun (Voltaire x Le Mexico), the dam of our stallion Ulysses M2S (by our stallion Ekstein), was awarded the predicate "Preferent" for producing two Ster mares and one Elite, Sport Showjumping mare. Under Morningside Stud's ownership Gudrun advanced from being a Keur mare to Keur Prestatie mare to Keur Prestatie mare.

Gudrun's sister, the Ster mare Deborah (G.Ramiro Z \times Le Mexico), was awarded the predicate "Preferent" for producing a Keur mare, a Ster mare, and a Keur Sport-Showjumping mare.

The Ster mare Ivresse (Ekstein x Nepal) was awarded the predicate "Preferent" for producing three Ster mares.

The Keur mare Miletto (Ekstein x Caletto I) was awarded the predicate "Preferent" for producing a stallion candidate and two Ster Prok mares.

Wang Chung M2S Wins 1.10 M. Class in the Netherlands

This weekend our stallions Wang Chung M2S and Ulysses M2S competed with very good results.

Wang Chung M2S won a 1.10 m. class in the Netherlands with 60 starters from all age groups. After jumping a clear first round with Eddie Brinkman Wang Chung had the fastest time among 17 horses in the jump-off to secure the victory. Eddie said that Wang Chung jumped "really well" and that he did not have to ride too fast because the stallion is learning to make sharp turns during the jump-off.

At the CSI2* Bois le Roi (France) show Ulysses M2S jumped doubleclear and placed 10th in one class and later jumped clear and placed 15th in a speed class without a jump-off. His co-owner and rider, the Belgian young rider Rossella de Simone, was very pleased with these results as she and Ulysses are now being trained by the Schroeder brothers and their style is different than her previous trainer's, Jos Lansink.

AES Nederland Approves Wang Chung M2S

Morningside Stud was officially informed today by an inspector in the Netherlands that our 4-year-old stallion Wang Chung M2S has been approved as a sire by the Anglo European Studbook. This approval was based on his initial grading in 2005, passing a 5-stage veterinary exam, passing a comprehensive x-ray exam, and his outstanding and consistent performance in showjumping in open competition in 2007.

Wang Chung M2S was sired by the international showjumper Royal Bravour (Ramiro x Orthos x Courville xx) and out of the KWPN Ster Preferent mare Harnita (Ahorn x Erdball xx). Wang Chung's damline has produced 5 approved stallions in the Netherlands, Germany, and Ireland and 3 international showjumpers. Wang Chung M2S was bred by Morningside Stud; he was registered at birth with the KWPN.

Wang Chung's first crop of foals was born in 2007. It is a uniform collection of high quality, well developed, and athletic foals characterized by "blood" and a quick hind leg. One filly foal, Cantopop M2S (Wang Chung M2S x Cruising x Ozymandias xx), has already been sold to South America. His one colt foal, Chien-Ming Wang M2S (Wang Chung M2S x Ekstein x Cruising), has been retained by Morningside Stud as a stallion prospect. Wang Chung M2S is trained and shown by the excellent Dutch rider Eddie Brinkman, who also produced Ulysses M2S for Morningside Stud. Wang Chung will continue competing with Brinkman with the goal of jumping at the Zwolle International Stallion Show in March 2008. Wang Chung M2S was graded S1 (passed conformation, health, and x-ray exams) as a 3-year-old by the Irish Horse Board and Morningside Stud hopes he will be approved by the IHB when he returns to Ireland in the next few years. In the meantime breeders can receive full studbook registration for their foals from the AES and Zangersheide studbooks.

Today in a 1.10 m. class at Laag Soeren with 60 starters of all ages Wang Chung M2S jumped double-clear and claimed 3rd place.

Wang Chung M2S 7th in Stallion Competition

Morningside Stud's Wang Chung M2S jumped two super clear rounds and placed 7th in the 1.10 metre 4-year-old stallion competition at the Euregio Indoor Denekamp Show today in the Netherlands.

Twenty-three stallions representing the Westfalen (3 stallions), Anglo European (2), Zangersheide (2), Belgian Warmblood (1), KWPN (6), Hanoverian (3), NRPS (2), Bayern (1), Irish Sport Horse (1), Oldenburg (1), and ZfdP (1) studbooks competed in the class. Wang Chung M2S represented the ISH studbook.

The class was judged by the 1996 Individual and Team Olympic Gold Medalist in Showjumping, Ulrich Kirchhoff.

Wang Chung M2S is a 2003 chestnut KWPN-registered stallion sired by the international showjumper Royal Bravour (by Ramiro) and out of the KWPN Ster Preferent mare Harnita (Ahorn x Erdball xx). Wang Chung M2S was bred by Morningside Stud and is being ridden for us in sport by the Dutch rider Eddie Brinkman. His first crop of foals was born this year.

Hickstead Wins \$1,000,000 Grand Prix at Spruce Meadows

The following news release was published by Jump Canada and concerns Hickstead, a grandson of Morningside Stud's stallion Ekstein:

"Eric Lamaze of Schomberg, ON became the second Canadian in history to win the world's richest Grand Prix, the \$1,000,000 CN International, held September 9 at the Spruce Meadows Masters in Calgary, AB. Lamaze found himself \$325,000 richer after being the only one out of 40 competitors to lay down double clear rounds, over one of the toughest classes in the world, built by Olympic course designer Leopoldo Palacios, of Caracas, Venezuela, who raised fences in the second round to the towering maximum height of 2.20 metres. Lamaze's partner was his seasoned international mount Hickstead, an 11-year-old Dutch Warmblood stallion owned by Torrey Pines and Ashland Stables Inc.

"This was really one of the best classes in the world, and to win was great for Canada and great for me," said Lamaze, who was the first Canadian to claim the CN International since Ian Millar's wins in 1987 and 1991. "This is a win I am going to remember for a long time!"

Lamaze picked up an additional \$50,000 for being the winner of the CN Precision series, which included the CN International Grand Prix, as well as three other major Grand Prix classes held at Spruce Meadows tournaments throughout the 2007 season. Having also won the \$200,000 ATCO Power Queen Elizabeth II Cup at the North American Tournament aboard Hickstead in early July, Lamaze's win on Sunday secured him the bonus prize.

The CN International capped off a week full of success for Lamaze, who was also fault-free with Hickstead in Saturday's two-round \$350,000 BMO Nations Cup, helping Canada earn third place.

It's been great the last few years. I've really been concentrating on my career and it is paying off now and for the future," explained Lamaze who was the 2007 Pan American Games Individual Bronze Medalist, as well as being a member of Canada's Show Jumping Team, helping them earn the Team Silver Medal, which in turn secured Canada's berth to the 2008 Olympics. "I've been traveling to Europe as much as I can to compete against the best in world. I'm going to go back to Europe for the month of October because it has really been paying off for both my young horses and for Hickstead, so it is something I am going to continue doing."

Recent Results and News

Ulysses M2S competed at the CSI** Show at Valkenwaard (Netherlands) last weekend in the International Jumping Competition for 6- & 7-Year Old Horses. On the first day with his co-owner, the Belgian junior rider Rossella de Simone, Ulysses M2S jumped double-clear. On the second day he jumped double-clear and placed 9th and won some prize money.

On July 1st the 10-year-old gelding For Fun II (by Whinny Jackson out of a mare by Ekstein) won the CSIO***** Grand Prix of Lummen with British rider James Davenport.

Itot du Chateau, the stallion by Le Tot de Semilly and out of the mare Sophie du Chateau, has been selected for the French Team for the European Showjumping Championship. The dam of Itot du Chateau is a half-sister to Morningside Stud's stallion Desir du Chateau.

In the last few weeks we have received an email and telephone call from eventing riders in England who have progeny of Condios showing great promise. Jason Hobbs wrote us that the 6-year-old Stilo Kontiko (bred by Tom Slattery) is a definite four star prospect with the movement and bold jump required for top sport. Michael Diamantides rang to tell us that 5-year-old XLNT Fast and Furioso (bred by Anne and Vincent Murphy) is very balanced in his flatwork and jumping and is going to be a very good eventing horse.

Wang Chung M2S competed in the Dutch 4-Year-Old Showjumping Championship and received high scores for jumping style and riding. Unfortunately he knocked the last fence in the course and Wang Chung missed qualifying for the final by a fraction of a point. Eddie Brinkman, the rider of Wang Chung M2S, told us that he jumped very well and several people were disappointed when Eddie told them that Morningside Stud is not selling the stallion. Wang Chung's first crop was born this year and they are all very good looking and athletic foals.

Hickstead (Hamlet x Ekstein), the world-class showjumper ridden by Canada's Eric Lamaze, recently won the Individual Bronze Medal and Team Silver Medal at the Pan American Games. Hickstead also placed 3rd in the Great West Life Cup at the CSI4* Spruce Meadows show and 1st in the ATCO Power Queen Elisabeth II Cup at the CSI5* Spruce Meadows show.

Our stallion Wang Chung M2S has qualified for the Dutch 4-Year-Old Showjumping Championship under Eddie Brinkman. Wang Chung will compete in the championship in August and in September he will be sent to a breeding station for two months to have his semen frozen for the EU, USA and Australia. With a very good first crop of foals born this year we are excited about this young stallion's potential for both sport and breeding.

Loughnavatta Papillon, bay 6-year-od gelding by Condios out of Ballinclover Penny (by Clover Hill), bred by Patrick Heffernan, owned by Rory Costigan, and ridden by Katie O'Sullivan, placed 1st in his first Pre-Novice Event at Ravensdale Lodge (Ireland) 17/06/2007.

One week later at Calverstown (Ireland) Loughnavatta Papillon placed 4th and jumped clear and with no time penalities in the cross country or showjumping in his first CNC* event.

In the Irish Horse Board's 5-Year-Old Championship Qualifier at the Galway County Show, Cavallino Cocktail, grey mare by Ekstein out of Tims Cavalier (by Cavalier Royale), bred by Ralph Conroy, owned by Linda Slattery, and ridden by Darragh Kenny, placed 1st.

In the Final on the next day Cavallino Cocktail placed 4th.

The 2006 4-Year-Old National Champion RoundThorn Madios (Condios x Clover Hill), bred by Denise Gleeson-McDonagh, owned by Patricia

Connon, and ridden by Catherine Thornton, has qualified for the 5-Year-Old Championship at the Dublin Horse Show.

Stilo Kontiko, by Condios out of a mare with no recorded breeding, bred by Tom Slattery, owned by Denise Crossman, and ridden by Jason Hobbs, placed 2nd in the Intermediate Event at Pontispool (UK) in April and 3rd in the Intermediate Event at Longleat International (UK) in June.

XLNT Fast and Furioso, (by Condios and out of a mare by Furisto), bred by Anne and Vincent Murphy, owned by XLNT Ltd., and ridden by Michael Diamantides, placed 4th in the Pre-Novice Event in Kelsall Hill (UK) in April, 7th in the Pre-Novice Event in Rodbaston (UK) in May, 3rd in the Pre-Novice Event in Somerford Park (UK) in May, and 1st in the OPre-Novice Event at Arley Hall (UK) in May.

USA Junior International Eventing Rider Purchases 50% of Two Colts

Morningside Stud is pleased to announce that we have sold 50% of two very exciting yearling eventing prospects to the family of US junior international eventing rider Callie Judy.

Both colts were bred by Morningside Stud and were sired by the Irish Sport Horse Conspiracy M2S (sired by the Holsteiner international showjumping stallion Condios and out of the Holsteiner international showjumping mare Corniola). Conspiracy M2S is a grey 5-year-old stallion pursuing a sport career in the Netherlands under Eddie Brinkman, and these two colts were part of Conspiracy's first crop registered by the Anglo European Studbook.

One colt, Bada Bing M2S, is out of a National Hunt racing mare named Danty Woman by the famous thoroughbred sire Roselier; this colt is a stallion prospect. The second colt, Beltway Bandit M2S, is out of a

KWPN Ster mare named Holiday by the very influential thoroughbred sire Mytens and out of the international showjumping mare Dante.

According to Callie Judy, "I spent the last week in May in Ireland with my parents searching for my next event horse. Tom Reed took my parents and me to see and try horses in counties Clare, Tipperary, Limerick and Down. He helped us find my next horse, a beautiful Irish mare we are naming Celtic Odyssey.

"We also looked at two of Tom's own yearlings, Bada Bing M2S and Beltway Bandit M2S. Both were fantastic to watch. Bada Bing has exceptional movement for a yearling, and Beltway Bandit has plenty of jump. I was so impressed with both of them that we are going into partnership with Tom, and I will be bringing them to the US to begin their training. I will start competing them in about four years, and I am confident they will be the next top event horses of their time.

"I value Tom's knowledge of jumping technique, conformation, and bloodlines. He breeds his horses to be exceptional athletes, and that is obvious in the two colts we will be bringing to the U.S. Thank you Tom for getting me together with these three wonderful horses!"

"I am delighted to now own Bada Bing M2S and Beltway Bandit M2S in partnership with the Judy family", said Tom Reed. "Callie is an exceptional young athlete and her parents are totally committed to helping Callie achieve her goal of being a professional eventing rider at the highest level. With the help of her trainers including the Olympic eventing rider Darren Chiacchia, Callie's successes to date include winning the Team Gold Medal at the 2006 North American Young Riders Eventing Championship; winning the 2006 USEA Area IV Preliminary division Championship; winning the 2006 Junior Young Rider division of the American Eventing Championships; Reserve Champion of the USEF One Star Eventing Championships; and being crowned the Junior Preliminary Rider of the Year in the United States by the USEA at the annual USEA Convention. What a start to an eventing career!"

Bada Bing M2S and Beltway Bandit M2S will leave Ireland for the USA in September.

Progeny of Morningside Stud stallions Condios, Ekstein and Desir du Chateau are continuing to perform very well in competitions in Ireland, UK, continental Europe, and the USA.

Stilo Kontiko, a bay 6-year-old gelding by Condios and out of an Irish Sport Horse mare with no recorded breeding, placed 2nd in his first Intermediate event in Pontispool, England. Stilo Kontiko was bred by Irish showjumper Tom Slattery (who competed Condios in 5-year-old classes in Ireland) and is owned now by Mrs. Crossman. Jason Hobbs, the rider, is quoted in the Horse & Hound as saying, "He's the best horse I've ever sat on."

Mis Condia, a bay 5-year-mare by Condios and out of the mare Ballin Clover Penny by Clover Hill, placed 2nd in the 5-year-Old Balmoral Championship Qualifier. Mis Condia was bred by Patrick Heffernan, was bought as a foal by the well-known young horse producer Pauric O'Neill, and was produced by Pauric's daughter Elaine (now 20-years-old). Although "I have never had a horse like that in all my life," Pauric recently sold the mare for a large sum to the excellent rider and producer Ronan McLoughlin, who secured the second place in the Balmoral qualifier.
